





- 1 container each of 2 contrasting color Beads. Either, Japanese seed beads or Delica beads size 11. (Czech beads are not uniform and have irregular holes. They do not work well for this technique). You could also use size 8 seed beads, if you like the larger bead look.
- Bead needle
- Bead Thread
- · Clasp & soldered jump ring or button to match.
- · Needle nose pliers (bring if you have).
- Table OTT light (bring if you have).

### FROM PASTOR DAVE

75 Years: "We HAVE to Celebrate!"



The father had no choice . . . he HAD to celebrate! His youngest son had publicly shamed the family by demanding his inheritance early, treating his father as if he were already dead and abandoning his responsibility to the family. The son had become lost to his father as he disappeared from sight on a journey to a distant country to find his "life."

In that place the youngest son had "thrown away" his life and experienced unspeakable humiliation. One day the father glimpsed what he had never expected but always hoped for, his son returning home. What would the father do? Use this opportunity to emphasize a life lesson? Demand a public apology? No! The son that he thought was dead was alive! The "lost" was "found!" The father interrupted his son's rehearsed confession speech with a bear hug, a kiss, a robe, a ring and a once in a lifetime meal! He HAD to celebrate! (The word "have/had/must" denotes absolute necessity. It is the same word used to indicate that Jesus "had to" die and rise again for the sins of the world.) The height of the celebration had to reflect the depth of what had happened. Nothing less than the best clothes and extravagant food would express the abundant love and forgiveness this family had experienced.

We have no choice ... we HAVE to celebrate! For 75 years God has been with this congregation in this place in deeply spiritual ways. Lives have been changed. Christ has been present as this congregation has gathered around the living Word and the life-giving sacraments of Baptism and Holy Communion. This originally Swedish Lutheran congregation today shouts emphatically that "all are welcome!" The Gospel has been proclaimed locally and globally in expected and unexpected ways. Before we were an official congregation this gathering was intentionally dedicated to nurturing faith through a Sunday School (1909) and two years later (1911) a Ladies Aid. Today we continue to "nurture the faith of all," in many ways.

We HAVE to celebrate, and the height of our celebration must reflect the depth of God's transforming power with us from 1943 to 2018! We are envisioning a year-long celebration from Good Shepherd Sunday in 2018 (April 22) to Good Shepherd Sunday 2019 (May 12). This time of celebration will involve:

Thanksgiving Thanking God with specificity for our past history

Vision Offering our gifts for the mission God is calling us to in the future Transformation Creating life changing experiences of worship, mission and nurture

We need your presence, suggestions, strengths and vision to fully realize the power of this anniversary!
