 - Discussion about the importance of emphasizing appeals (Ascend, Give to the Max). We wrote \$20,100 into our budget last March for general expenses, and we are at YTD \$12,095.

 - LCGS currently does not have anything for historical documents. We currently have a lock box off-site that Christine has access to. Pastor Lisa will look into this with staff and purchase what they deem necessary.
